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Congratulations! You have qualified and been selected to receive funding from the Saskatchewan Amateur Wrestling Association (SAWA) and its' Athlete Assistance Funding Program (Senior Card).

The funds allotted for the Senior Card Funding Program must go towards your training expenses to help you prepare for the Provincial and National Championships. Senior card funding is worth a maximum of \$1,000.00 for each university athlete (classified as a full-time student) and \$500.00 for each non-university athletes, which will be paid out in two installments. All post-secondary students are required to submit an official copy of their Confirmation of Enrollment. This document can be emailed to the SAWA office at sk.wrestling@shaw.ca or mailed to the address above.

Please review the enclosed contracts carefully, and submit each one, signed, to the SAWA office in Saskatoon by January 5, 2010. If you do not confirm acceptance of your carding by this date, the funding will drop to the next eligible wrestler on the carding list.

In order to receive your first half allotment, you must compete in a minimum of two carding tournaments prior to January 1, 2010 and be current members of SAWA.

SAWA Policy and Procedure 6.1.3 states: "... all athletes must be registered with SAWA, at the date of the carding tournament in which they attend to receive carding points. If they are not registered at the date of the carding tournament, they will not receive their carding points."

All of these guidelines and schedules must be followed or you may forfeit either all or a portion of your allotment. If you have any questions do not hesitate to contact me at the SAWA office. Once again, congratulations and have a great season!
