**2011 Western Canada Summer Games (WCSG)  
Head Coach, Assistant Coach, Manager  
Application Deadline August 15, 2010**

SAWA is accepting coaches and manager applications for the 2011 WCSG. The Head Coach will be responsible for working with the SAWA Canada Games Coaches in developing, training, preparing and coaching the athletes identified to compete at the 2011 WCSG in Kamloops, British Columbia.

The Head and Assistant Coaches will be responsible for attending meetings scheduled by the Sask Games Council, and reporting on these meetings to the Board of Directors of the Sask Amateur Wrestling Assoc. Successful candidates selected to coach and manage the 2011 WCSG Team must comply with the SAWA Policy and Procedures Manual.

Coach Qualifications:

4. Eligibility: *as per WCSG Technical Package*

4.1 Coaches:

Any staff listed as head coach on the official registration form must be fully certified (theory, technical and practical) under the National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) to at least Level 3, or the equivalent level in the new NCCP, competition stream, Development context, (Trained status) in Wrestling.

The Assistant Coach must be NCCP Competition Intro Certified in Wrestling.

Coaching certification must be completed no later than ninety (90) days before the opening of the Games.

*as per SAWA Policy & Procedures*

1. Actively coaching within Saskatchewan
2. Experience in coaching athletes at the provincial and national level.

The manager for the 2011 WCSG will be responsible for providing coaching and administrative support to the Head Coach and Assistant Coach of the team. The manager will be responsible for the supervision of the athletes while in competition at the Games.

Manager Qualifications: as per SAWA Policy & Procedures

1. Must be fully certified Level 1 (or its equivalent in the new NCCP) at least 90 days prior to the start of the Games.
2. Developing coach, and actively coaching within Saskatchewan.
3. Actively involved in the NCCP.

Applicants must be fully certified and current SAWA members in good standing in order for their application to be accepted for consideration for these positions. Applications that do not meet the criteria will not be accepted. SAWA will not be applying for any coaching exemptions. Experience at the 2011 Saskatchewan Winter Games will be an asset.
