1. NCCP Wrestling Competition Introduction (CI) Part A Clinic

- NCCP Wrestling Competition Introduction Part A has replaced the NCCP Level 1 Technical and Theory and is required to coach at the Provincial Championships.
- This course is specifically designed for the sport of wrestling.
- On successful completion of this course, participants will be NCCP Wrestling Competition Introduction Part A Trained.
- Classroom sessions include: Ethics, Nutrition, Practice Development, Intro to Coaching
- On mat sessions follow the Level 1 NCCP Technical Course and will utilize the CanCoach CDROM

2. NCCP Wrestling Competition Introduction (CI) Part A and B Evaluation

- Coaches who have completed both their **NCCP Wrestling Competition Introduction (CI) Part A and B** may challenge for Evaluation.
- **Coaches who currently have Level 2 NCCP must challenge for certification and successfully complete it prior to Sept. 2008 or they will be required to take CI Part A & B. (i.e. they will lose their prior NCCP level)**
- Coaches must do some course work prior to challenging for certification. Information regarding course work is available from Sask. Wrestling or on the Sask Wrestling website:

- Coaches will be expected to run a practice session during the weekend
- Coaches interested in challenging for certification must apply by Nov. 2, 2007
