IF an individual is in their FIRST YEAR of grade 12 and born in 1990, this will be an exception and will be allowed to compete in the tournament.  
IF the individual is upgrading their grade 12 year (5<sup>th</sup> year of High School) and is a first year Junior (1990), this will not be accepted.  
IF either of these situations exists, please notify Todd Hinds.

Young Women - 40, 44, 48, 52, 56, 60, 65, 70, 85 and 85+ KG.
