

# Miller Wrestling Classic

## General Information:

**Date:** Friday January 11<sup>th</sup> 4:00pm – 9:00pm  
Saturday January 12<sup>th</sup> 9:00am – Completion  
Note: the novice and elite tournaments will be running simultaneously in separate gymnasiums.

**Venue:** Miller Comprehensive High School

**Division:** High School Elite Boys and Girls  
High School Novice Boys and Girls

**Entry Fee:** \$15.00 per entry

### Skin Check:

Please ensure a thorough skin check is done on the athletes prior to the competition. If the athlete is questionable, don't enter them in the competition. An athlete may be pulled out of the tournament if a skin problem is detected.

### Gate:

A nominal fee will be charged to spectators and parents at the gate

**Canteen:** Canteen will be available throughout the day

**Lunch:** Lunch will be provided to all coaches and advisors on Saturday

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## **High School Senior/Elite Division:**

### **Eligibility:**

If an athlete meets any of the following criteria they **must** compete in the elite competition and cannot compete in the novice competition.

1. They are currently a grade 11 or 12 student, with a minimum of one-year previous wrestling experience.
2. They placed in the top 4 at last year's high school provincial championships.
3. They placed in the top 6 at the Canadian Juvenile National Championships or the top 4 at the Canadian Cadet National Championships.

**Weigh-Ins:** Wednesday January 9<sup>th</sup> after 3:00pm

Weigh-ins is to be done by a coach or school administrator  
Weigh-in must be e-mailed to Mark Fitzpatrick no later than 12:00 noon on Thursday January 10<sup>th</sup>. A confirmation e-mail will be returned by Friday morning.

**2kg weight allowance on all weight classes**

### **Weight Classes:**

Male: 42, 46, 50, 54, 58, 63, 68, 74, 81, 90, 105, 105-130

Female: 44, 48, 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 81, 88, 88-100

### **Awards:**

Individual medals for first, second, and third place in each weight class

Outstanding Male wrestler

Outstanding Female Wrestler

\*\*\*Outstanding wrestlers will be voted on by the coaches. One ballot per team\*\*\*

Boys team champion

Girls team champion

\*\*\* All wrestlers that place in the top six will be used to determine the team standings\*\*\*

\*\*\* Weight classes with less than six entries will not be adjusted (a first place will still accumulate 10 team points. \*\*\*

\*\*\* Ties will be broken by the number of individual 1<sup>st</sup> places. \*\*\*

**Rules:** CAWA rules with SHSAA modifications. Athletes will not have to tape their laces

**Draw:**

The draw will be a double elimination bracket draw for all weight classes with more than 5 wrestlers. Any weight class with 5 or fewer entries will be a pool format.

**High School Novice Tournament:**

**Eligibility:**

Any wrestler who does not meet the criteria for the Elite tournament may compete in the Novice tournament.

**Weigh-In** Wednesday January 9 after 3:00pm

Weigh-ins is to be done by a coach or school administrator

Weigh-in must be e-mailed to Mark Fitzpatrick Miller no later than 12:00 noon on Thursday January 10<sup>th</sup>. A confirmation e-mail will be returned by Friday morning.

**Scratch weight for all Novice wrestlers.**

**Weight Classes:**

Athletes will be pooled according to scratch weight. Weight classes will be pooled based on SHSAA criteria.

**Draw:**

Round robin pools of 5 or 6 (if possible).

**Awards:**

Boys Team Champions

Girls Team Champions

Top placer in each pool (note: pool champions will be based on win/loss record. In case of a tie, positive points will be used, then #of pins.)
