General Information:

Date: *Novice Tournament* – Friday, February 12th, 2010 1:00 p.m. – Completion
Elite Tournament – Saturday, February 13th, 2010 9:00 a.m. – Completion

Venue: Archbishop M.C. O'Neill High School

Entry Fee: *Novice Tournament* - \$10.00 per wrestler
Elite Tournament - \$10.00 per wrestler
Both Novice & Elite - \$15.00 per wrestler

Eligibility: **Novice athletes may wrestle in both tournaments.** Only athletes who are currently eligible to compete at their provincial high school championships are eligible. High school teams only. No club teams are allowed in the competition.

Med. Info: Please ensure a thorough skin check is done on the athletes prior to the competition. If the athlete is questionable, do not enter them in the competition. An athlete may be pulled out of the tournament if a skin problem is detected.

Due to the recent H1N1 outbreaks, please ensure that all wrestlers are in good health to allow for safe participation for themselves and others.

Medical personnel will be on site throughout the tournament if any medical issues arise.

Rules: CAWA rules with SHSAA modifications. Athletes will not be required to tape their laces.

Gate: A nominal fee will be charged to spectators and parents at the gate. Each team will be given "Coaches Passes" based on the number of wrestlers the team enters in competition (1:8 Ratio).

HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR/ELITE COMPETITION:

Saturday, February 13th – 9:00 a.m. - Completion

Eligibility:

If an athlete meets any of the following criteria they **must** compete in the elite competition and cannot compete in the novice competition.

1. They are currently a grade 11 or 12 student, with a minimum of one year previous wrestling experience.
2. They placed in the top 4 at last year's high school provincial championships.
3. They placed in the top 6 at the Canadian Juvenile National Championships or the top 4 at the Canadian Cadet National Championships.
4. Competed as a part of a provincial team in the 2009 Canada Summer Games.

Weigh-Ins:

There will be an on-site weigh in Friday February 12th at Archbishop M.C. O'Neill from 4:30 – 5:30 p.m. Any athlete competing in the elite tournament must weigh in. There will be a **0.2 kg. weight allowance**. If an athlete is wrestling in the novice tournament and wants to compete in the elite tournament they must weigh in. **A scale to check weight will be put out at 3:30. Athletes can not check weight anytime before then.**

Weight Classes:

Male: 40, 43, 46, 49, 52, 55, 58, 62, 66, 70, 75, 82, 90, 98, 110, 130

Female: 44, 47, 50, 53, 56, 60, 64, 68, 73, 80, 90, 105

There will be a 0.2kg weight allowance on all weight classes

Awards:

Individual medals for first, second, and third place in each weight class

Outstanding Male wrestler

Outstanding Female Wrestler

Outstanding wrestlers will be voted on by the coaches. One ballot per team

Boys Team Champion

Girls Team Champion

*** All wrestlers that place in the top six will be used to determine the team standings***

*** Weight classes with less than six entries will not be adjusted (a first place will still accumulate 10 team points. ***

*** Ties will be broken by the number of individual 1st places. ***

Rules:

CAWA rules with SHSAA modifications. Athletes will not have to tape their laces

Draw:

The draw will be a double elimination bracket draw for all weight classes with more than 5 wrestlers. Any weight class with 5 or fewer entries will be a pool format.

HIGH SCHOOL NOVICE TOURNAMENT:

Friday, February 12th – 1:00p.m. - Completion

Eligibility:

Any wrestler who does not meet the criteria for the Elite tournament may compete in the Novice tournament.

Weight Classes:

Athletes will be pooled according to scratch weight. Weight classes will be pooled based on SHSAA criteria.

Draw:

Round robin pools of 4 or 5 (if possible).

Girls Team Champion

Top placer in each pool (note: pool champions will be based on win/loss record. In case of a tie, positive points will be used, then # of pins.)
